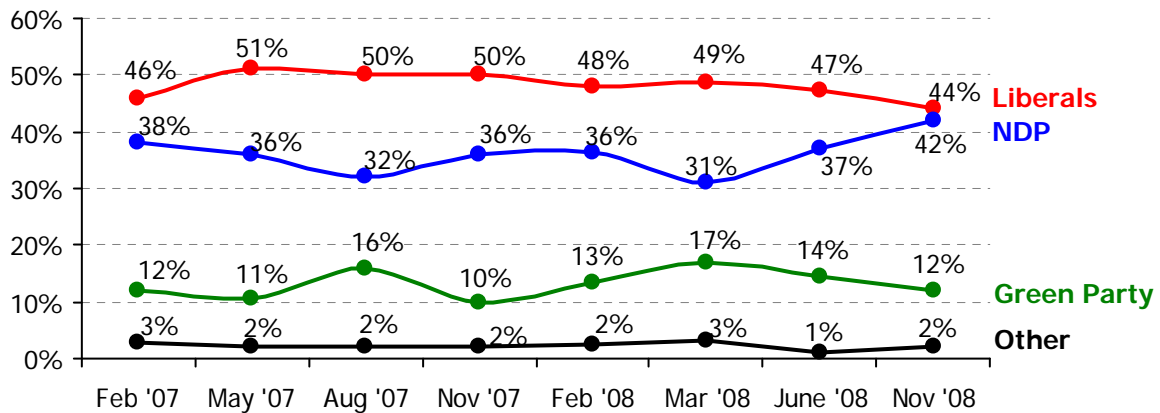

Re: BC Liberals and NDP Neck and Neck

The most recent Mustel Group poll (taken November 14th-22nd) indicates that the BC Liberals and NDP are essentially neck and neck. If an election were held tomorrow, the BC Liberals would have the support of 44% of decided voters and the NDP would be supported by 42%.

Over the past year, residents of BC's Interior and women have been most inclined to shift from the BC Liberals to the NDP.

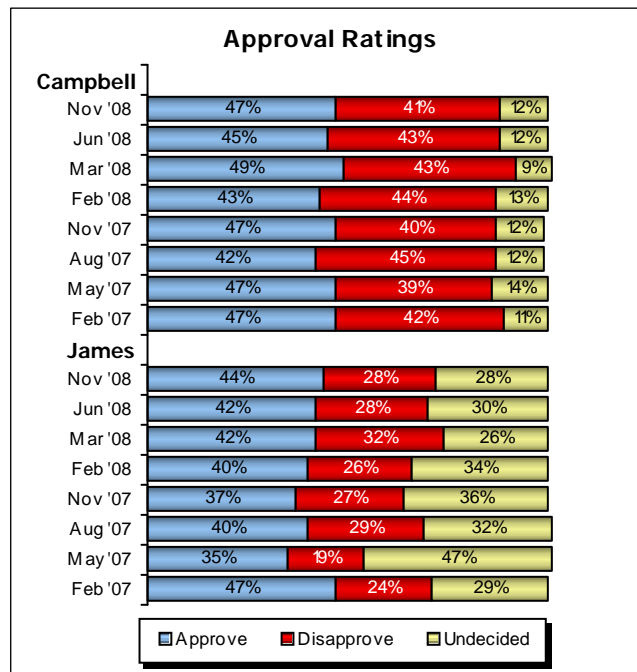
Provincial Voter Intention



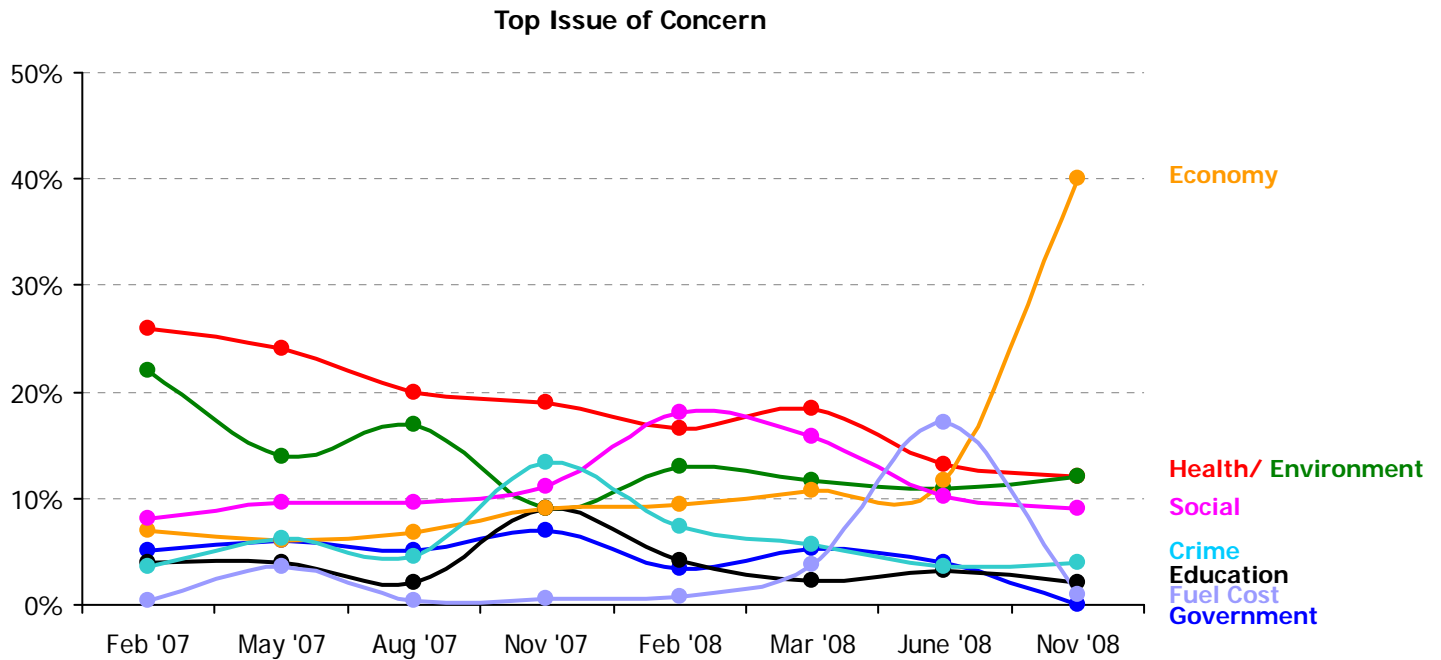
Currently 47% approve of Premier Campbell's performance in contrast to 41% disapproving, consistent with past measures.

A total of 44% approve of the performance of Carol James, 28% disapprove and the remaining 28% are undecided (also relatively consistent with past measures).

Other findings from the survey show that concern about the economy dominates all other issues.

Margin of error: ±4.4% at the 95% confidence level; Undecided: 17%

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
